**LIVE ANIMALS IN SMALL ENCLOSED  
CONTAINER THAT FITS ON PASSENGER'S LAP OR  
UNDER SEAT. (EXCEPTION: SERVICE ANIMALS)**

### BOARDING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PASSENGERS:

- If they fail to pay fare, present valid pass or transfer.
- If they appear to be intoxicated, on liquor or drugs.
- If they are engaged in activities that violate any other law or ordinance.
