

SERVICE CHANGES: Effective December 13, 2020

ROUTES 16, 19, 20, 31, 32

The Department of Transportation Services conducted surveys on proposed changes to the following routes from October 2019 through October 2020.

Based on the survey results, the following routes will be modified:

Route 16 *Moanalua Valley*

- Route 16 will be renumbered to Route 302 Moanalua Valley. Current routing will not change.

Route 19 *Waikiki-Airport-Hickam*

- Route 19 will be discontinued & existing service will be combined with the Route 20 schedule.
- Service to Hickam will be replaced by new Route 303 Hickam-Kalihi Transit Center.

Route 20 *Waikiki- Pearlridge*

- Service from the discontinued Route 19 will be combined with the current Route 20 schedule and will increase weekday service frequency to approximately 20 minutes for the majority of the day.
- In the westbound direction, Route 20 will be realigned to operate on South Street instead of Alakea Street and provide a connection at the Alapai Transit Center.

Route 31 *Tripler-Mapunapuna*

- Route 31 will be discontinued and replaced with new Routes 301 (Tripler-Kalihi Transit Center) and 303 (Hickam-Kalihi Transit Center).

Route 32 *Kalihi Transit Center-Pearlridge*

- Service on Puuloa Road will be discontinued and replaced by two-way service on Kikowaena, Ahua, and Pukoloa Streets. Riders may access Puuloa Road via Routes on Nimitz Highway or Pukoloa Street.

“New” Route 301 *Tripler-Kalihi Transit Center*

- Route 301 will provide direct service between Kalihi Transit Center-Tripler Hospital and replaces the Tripler segment of discontinued Route 31.

“New” Route 302 *Moanalua Valley*

- Route 16 is renumbered to Route 302. There are no changes to the current routing that provides service between Moanalua Valley-Red Hill-Kalihi Transit Center.

“New” Route 303 *Hickam-Airport-Kalihi Transit Center*

- Route 303 will provide service between Hickam-Airport-Kalihi Transit Center and replaces the Hickam segment of discontinued Route 19 and the Airport segment of discontinued Route 31. Route 303 will utilize the H-1 Freeway between Kalihi Transit Center and Honolulu Airport to deliver faster service.
