Service Changes in Response to COVID-19 Impacts to Ridership

Effective: Sunday, May 30, 2021

It has been a year since TheBus service was changed in response to the drastic drop in ridership and revenues. The effects of the pandemic continue to impact TheBus, therefore, starting Sunday, May 30, 2021, service times will be reduced for the following routes.

Route 301 Tripler-Kalihi Transit Center

- Service will end at 7:00 pm
 - Last trip departs Kalihi Transit Center at 6:40 pm on weekdays and 6:20 pm on weekends.

Route 302 Moanalua Valley-Kalihi Transit Center

- New service times:
 - Morning
 - Departs Kalihi Transit Center at 5:47 am & 6:17 am
 - Afternoon
 - Departs Kalihi Transit Center at 5:39 pm

Route 303 Hickam-Airport-Kalihi Transit Center

- Service will end at 8:00 pm
 - Eastbound
 - Last trip departs Hickam at 7:40 pm on weekdays and 7:20 pm on weekends.
 - Westbound
 - Last trip departs Kalihi Transit Center at 7:50 pm on weekdays and 7:30 pm on weekends.

The Department of Transportation Services and Oahu Transit Services continue to monitor/evaluate TheBus service and adjust service levels to reduce or eliminate excessively underutilized routes/trips.
