Before you begin your travels on TheBus, you will want to make your plans ahead of time.

Plan Your Trip

Simply call TheBus Information Department at (808) 848-5555, press 2 to find your nearest bus stop as well as route and schedule information.

- Have a pen and paper available to write down the information.
- Provide the information representative with the following:
 - Where you are starting your trip from;
 - Where you want to go;
 - When you need to be at your destination.

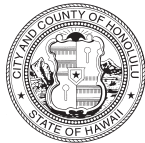

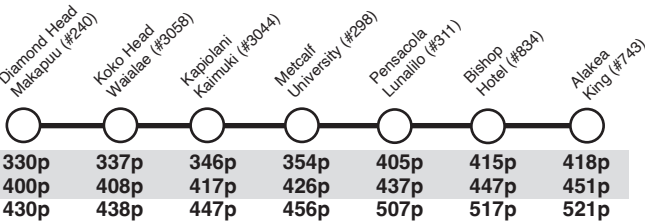
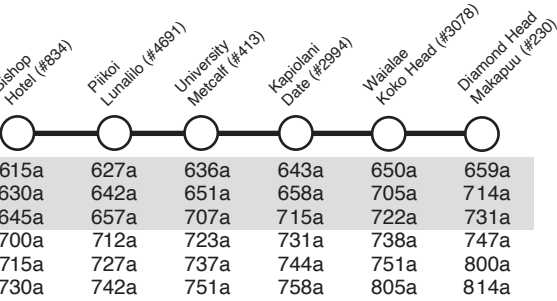

ROUTE U1 EXPRESS P.M. BUS STOPS

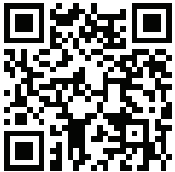
